

Student Transportation To and From School

Policy No. 406.1

The Board of Education, School District No. 91 (Nechako Lakes), works to provide students of the school district with a safe, effective and efficient transportation system.

The Board desires to provide transportation to students who live beyond an acceptable limit to an established bus route stop or to a school in which there is an educational program for that student. The Board shall determine what is an acceptable limit.

The Board considers the riding of the school buses a privilege. The Board expects all students transported to obey the Code of Conduct, Policy and Regulation No. 301.5, and other applicable guidelines.

In principle, the Boards' priority will be to transport students to their assigned schools as defined in *School Attendance Area, Policy and Regulation No. 301.1 and 301.1R*.

Adult students aged 19 years and older must undergo a criminal record check (completed at their own expense) when seeking approval from the Manager of Transportation, or designate.
