

Statement of Guiding Principles for Business Procedures

Policy No. 403.0

The Board of Education, School District No. 91 (Nechako Lakes), recognizes that it is accountable to the public for the wise and prudent use of the public funds that support the operations of the school district.

The Board expects that all business procedures will conform to generally accepted best business management practices and will be clearly understood. The business procedures should be both efficient and effective.

The Board expects that procedures will be in place to safeguard the assets and inventory of the district.

Further, the Board expects that there will be open and honest sharing of information regarding the business procedures of the district with public access to the records.

Finally, the Board expects that all expenditures of funds will contribute to maximizing learning opportunities for students.
