

Emergency Situations

Policy No. 402.9

The Board of Education, School District No. 91 (Nechako Lakes), believes that it has a responsibility to ensure that plans and procedures are in place to cope with emergency situations.

There are many kinds of situations that could endanger the lives of students and other personnel in schools such as fire, bomb threats, toxic gases and natural disasters. Because no two instances are identical nor are the physical plants similar, emergency plans must anticipate a variety of situations and conditions that differ from building to building.

The Board expects that the Superintendent of Schools, or designate, to ensure that district procedures are developed to cope with emergencies, and that administrators and managers in charge of each school or site develop emergency plans for their own building.

The Board further expects that all school district staff will be made aware of these procedures. The procedures will be reviewed and revised from time to time, as circumstances warrant.
