Policy No. 302.2

The Board of Education, School District No. 91 (Nechako Lakes), recognizes that students have diverse needs, backgrounds and experiences. For some students, an offsite Alternate Education program is an option that can provide additional support through differentiated instruction, flexible programming and enhanced personalized services such as cultural and health services.

In accordance with the Ministry of Education's *Alternate Education School Program Policy*, the Board supports establishing and operating offsite Alternate Programs that meet all provincial/district policies and operational regulations to support the learning of students.
