The kids can pretend to be a doctor and administer band-aids on the bear's boo-boos, while practicing letters at the same time! Each boo-boo is actually a letter and your child matches the band-aid that has the matching letter on top of the boo-boo. They can match uppercase letters, lowercase letters, or both uppercase and lowercase letters together.

You can use real band-aids instead. Just use a sharpie to write the letter on top of each band-aid.

Materials needed:

Band-aids

Game board

Alphabet or sight word cards

Directions: The child turns over the band-aid and read the letter/word and covers it on the bear booboo. The first child to cover all the booboo's is the winner.
