International Students

Tuition fees will be established by the Superintendent of Schools, or designate, for all international students from grades 5 to 12 requesting schooling in the school district. Specific tuition information can be found on the student application form.

International students enrolled in the school district are expected to have a level of proficiency in English and academic ability such that additional services are not required. Where additional services are required, additional fees may be assessed.

The final determination for admission of international students shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent of Schools, or designate. Where the district is required to provide housing for the student, homestay fees will be charged in addition to tuition.

Reciprocal student exchange programs will be supported and encouraged by the Board of Education if there appears to be a strong possibility that School District No. 91 (Nechako Lakes) students will participate. No tuition fee will be assessed for students participating in a reciprocal exchange program. An annual review of reciprocal exchange programs will be done by the Superintendent of Schools, or designate.
