

Sight word Soccer



Supplies:
Soccer field
Milk lids

Assembly

Cut out the circle sight words. Attach one small soccer ball to the underside of the milk lid. Copy and cut out the larger soccer balls. Put a sight word on the back of each soccer ball.

To play the game:

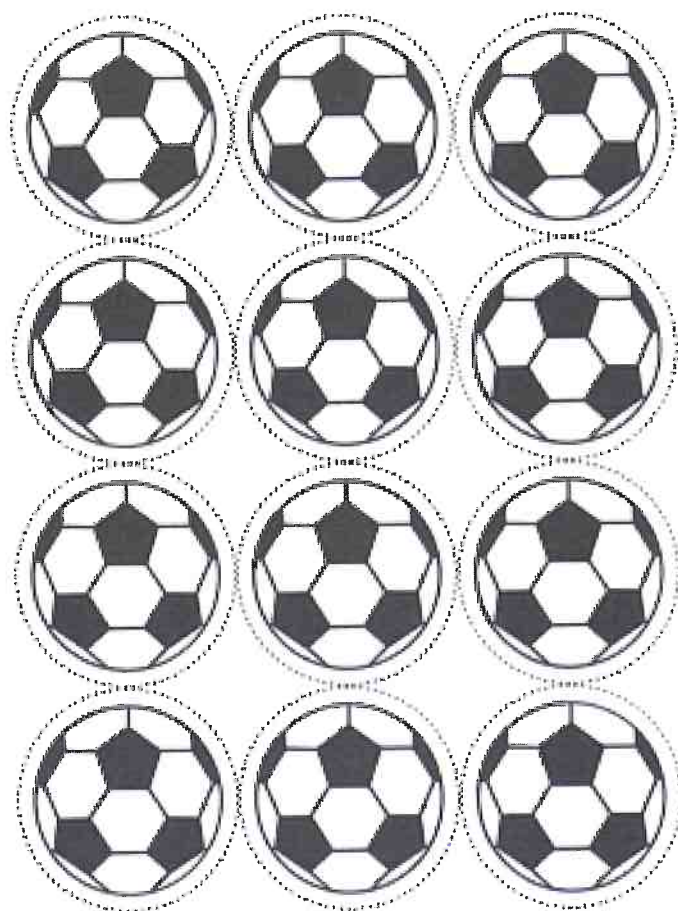
Put the large soccer balls in a pile. Have the child pick the top soccer ball and read the word on the back. If the child reads the word correctly then they may take a shot on the goal. Using two fingers, they will flick the top of the milk lid towards the goal. If they get the ball in the goal then they get a point. The child with the most points wins the soccer game.

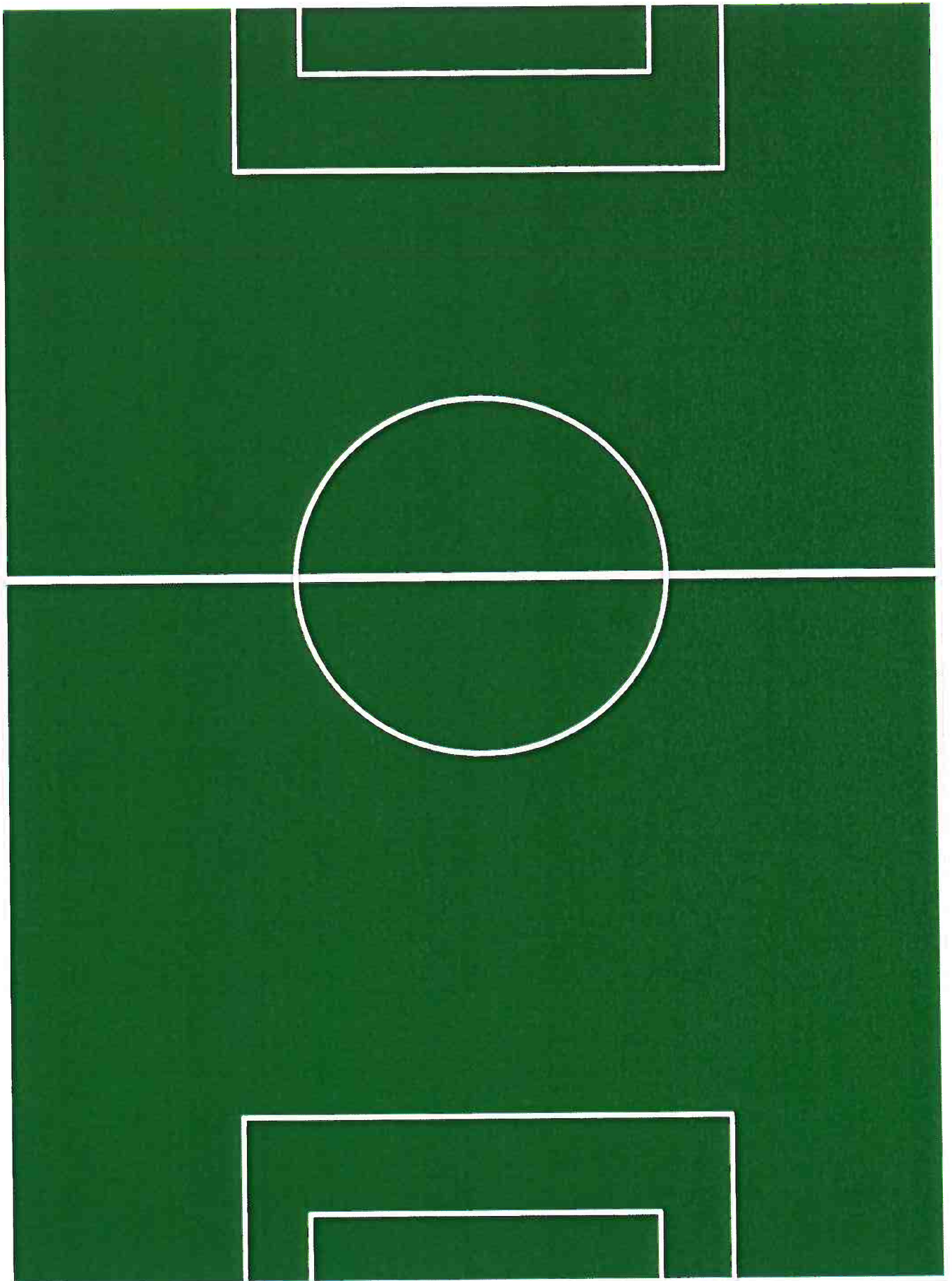
A fun next step:

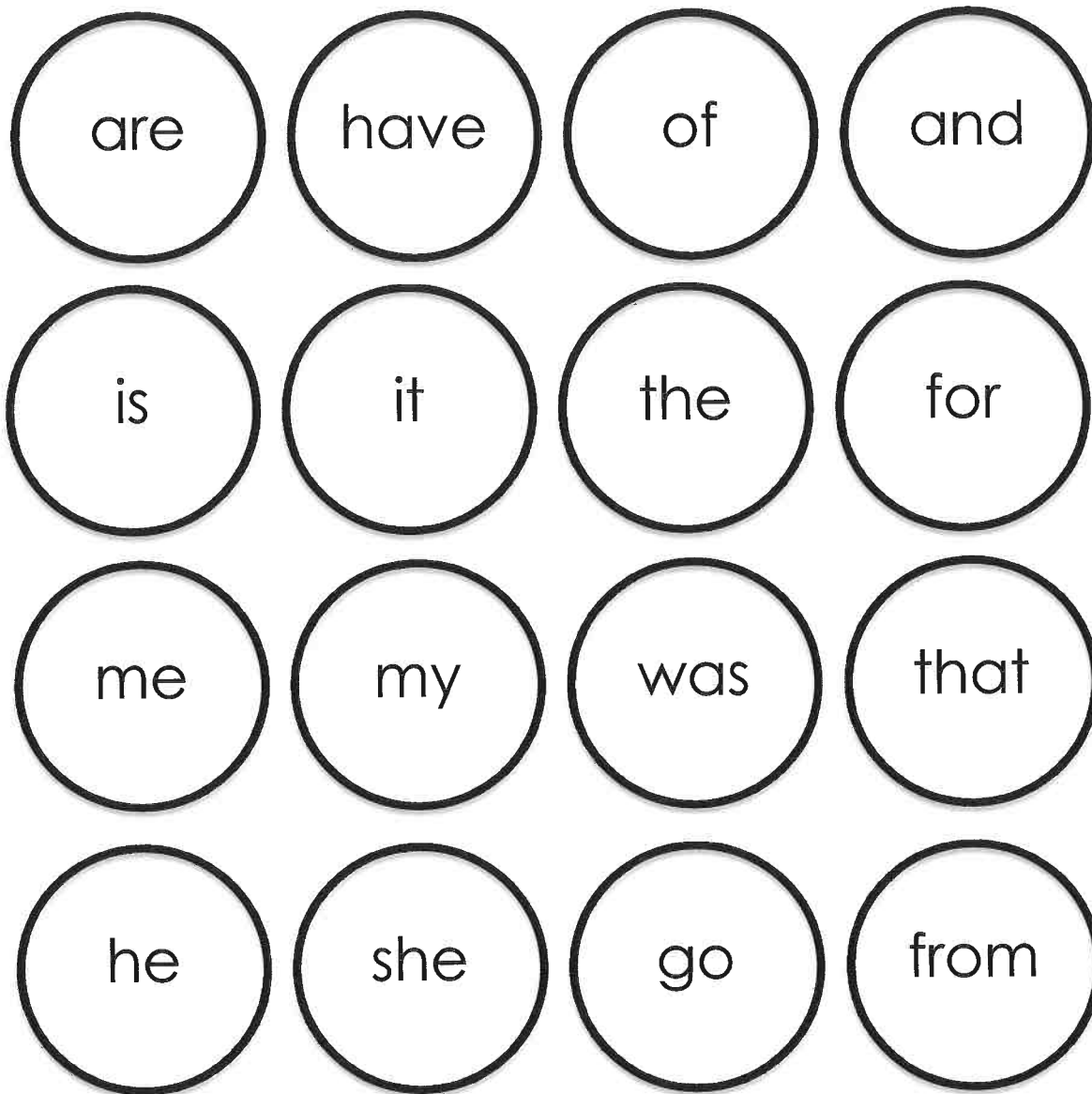

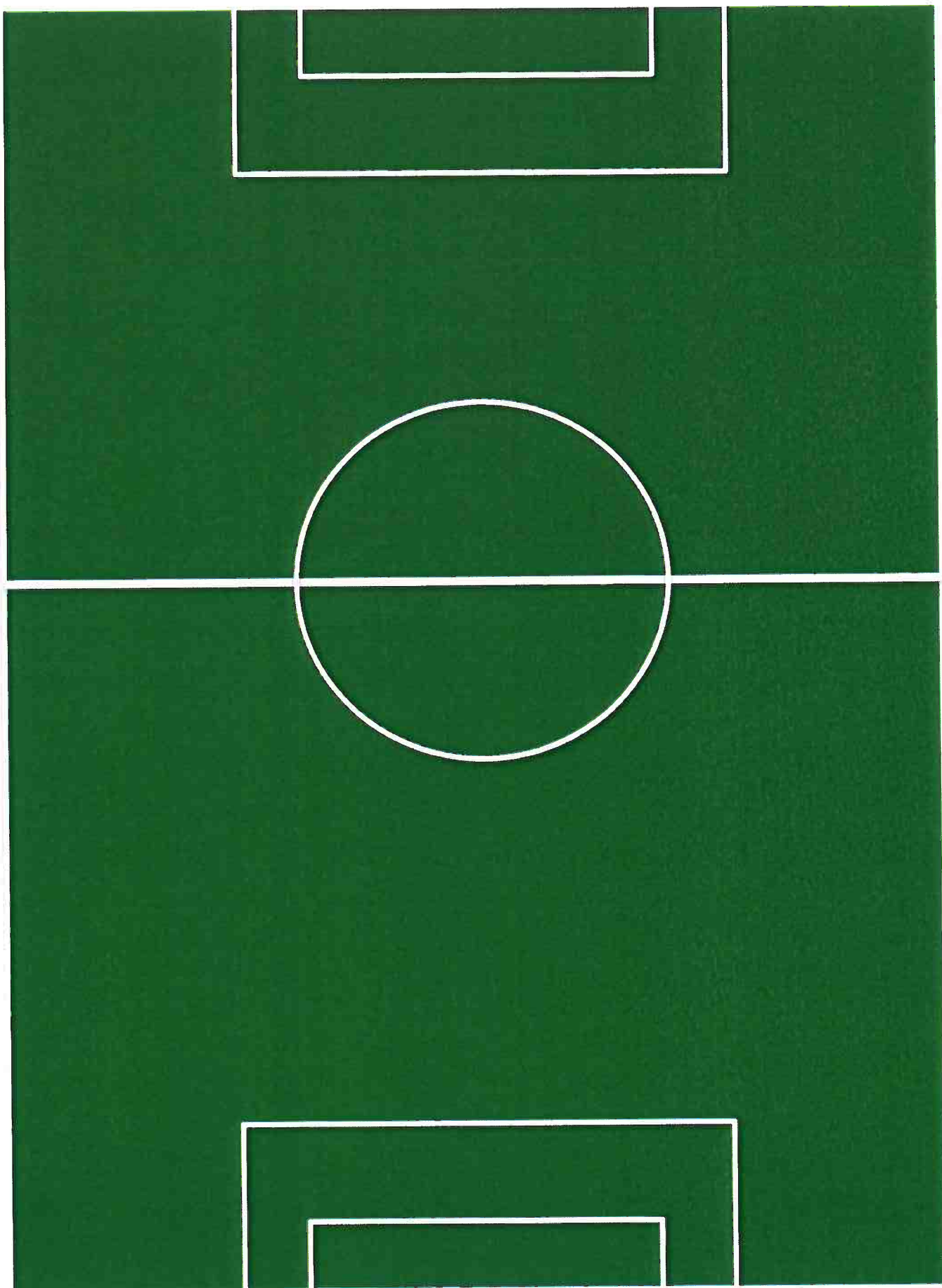


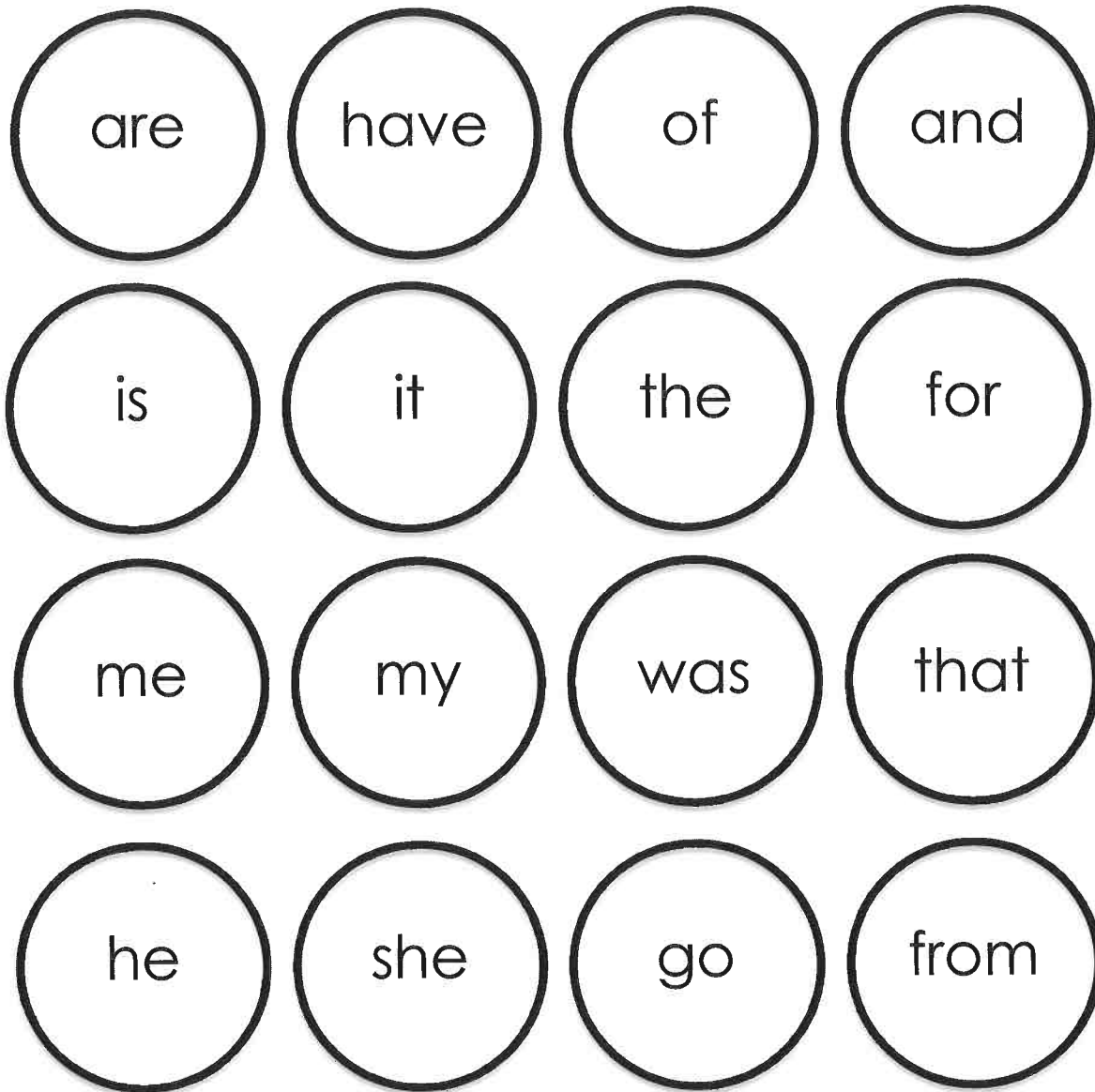
