

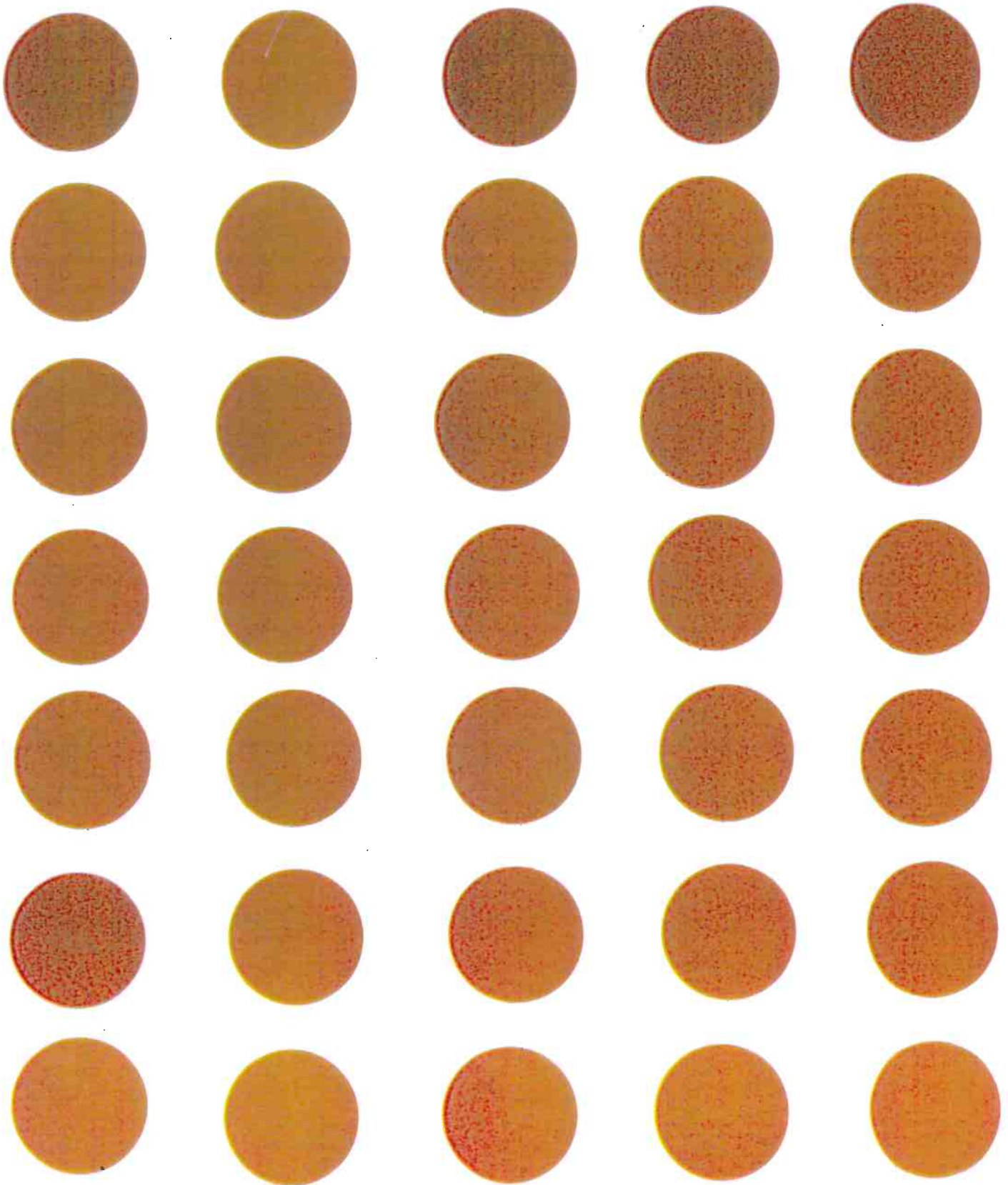
How to Play

Grades K-1

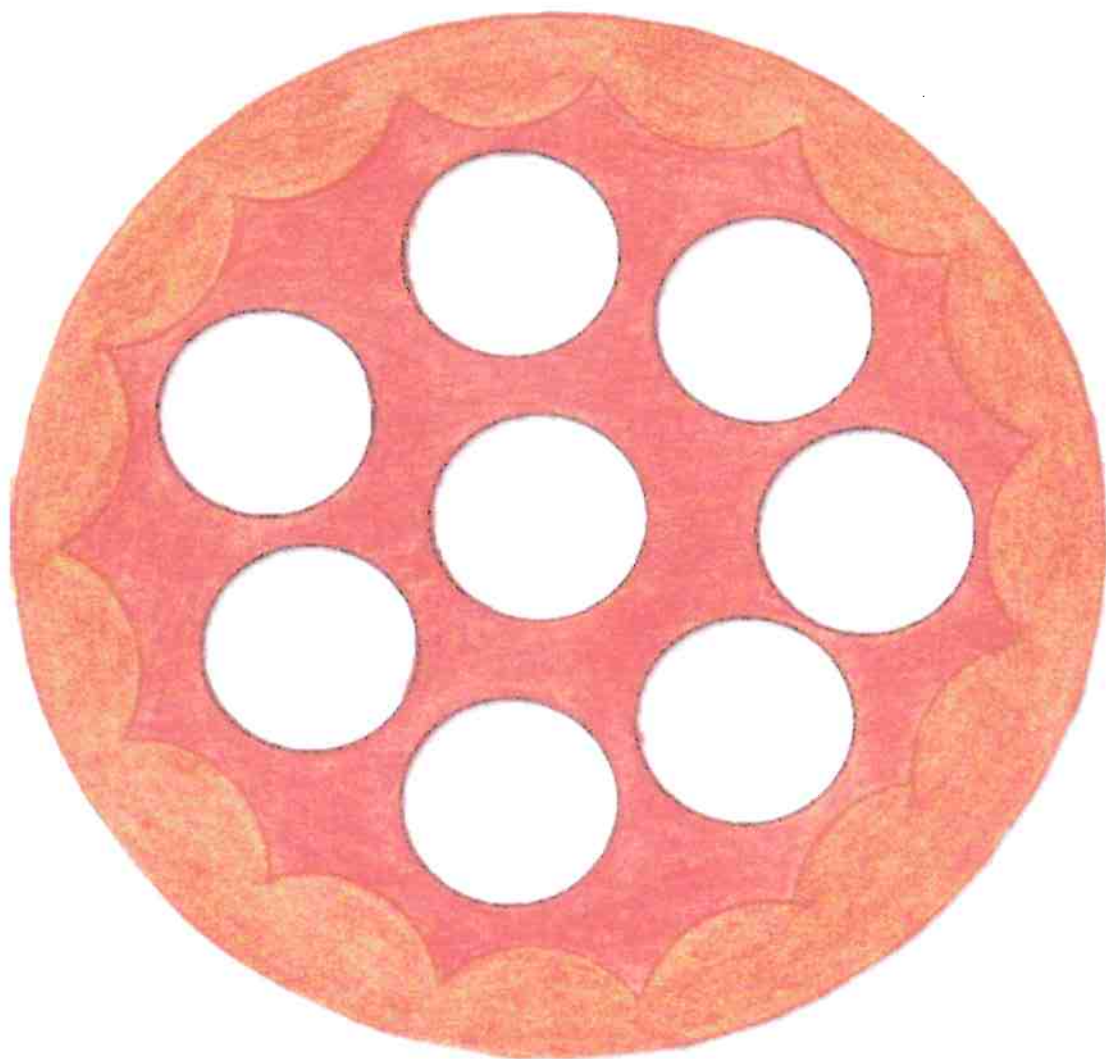
1. Pass out a game card. Give the players enough pepperoni markers to cover their card. (I just grab a few and give every two or three pepperoni pieces. There are usually enough to share.)
2. Open the PowerPoint game (Pizza Bingo). The first slide is the title slide. The second slide is the standard and directions slide.
3. The game starts at slide 3. The teacher or leader reads the word. Students repeat the word.
4. Students check their cards to see if they have the word. If they do then they place a pepperoni on that word.
5. Keep going in the same fashion until someone calls out, "I've Got a Pizza!"
6. That means that person has filled up his/her card. The player reads his words to the class. You can end the game at this time or play again.



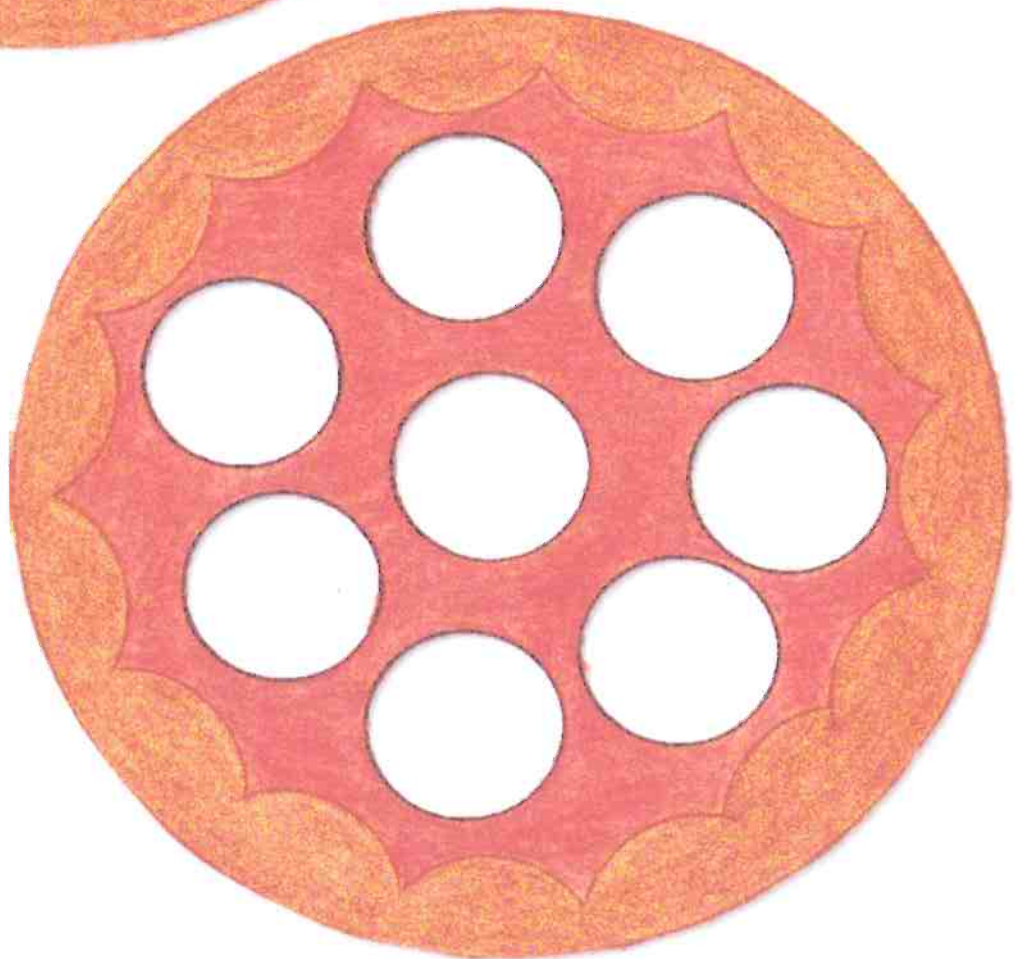
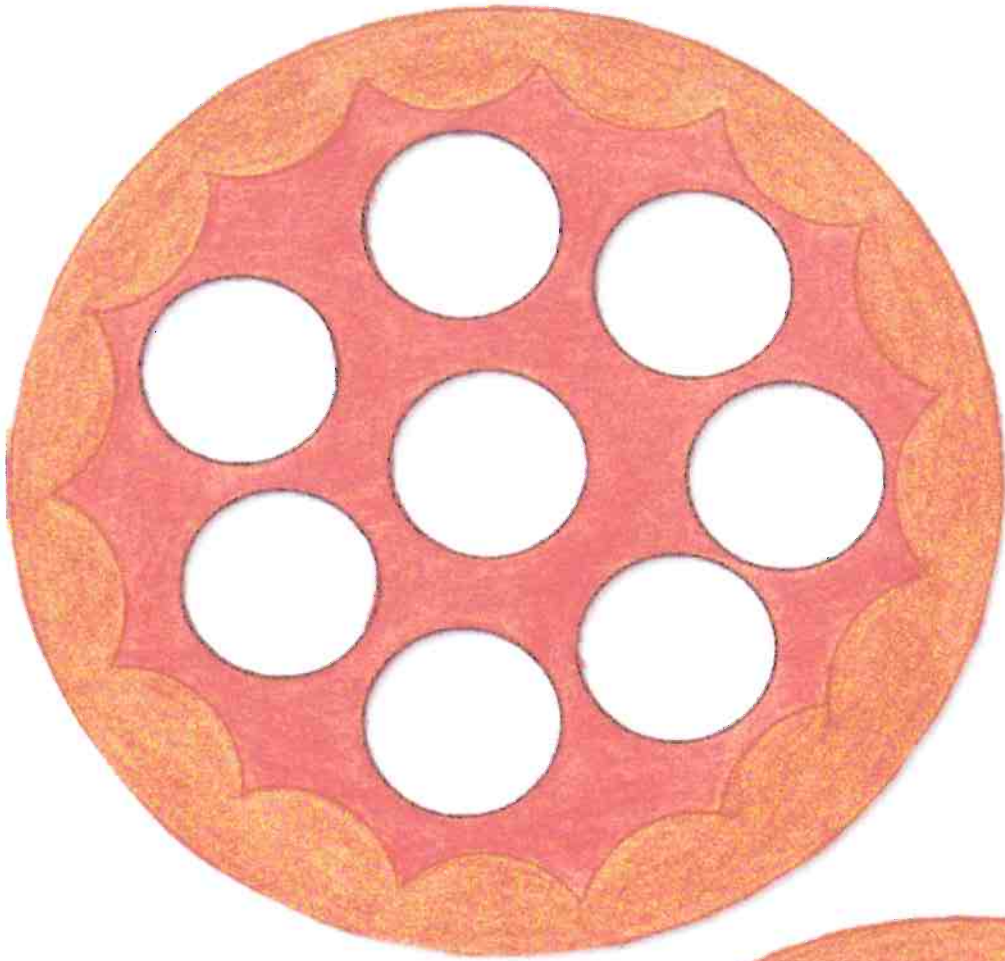
Run these off on white paper. Run as many copies as you need. If you have 20 children, you will need 160 circles.

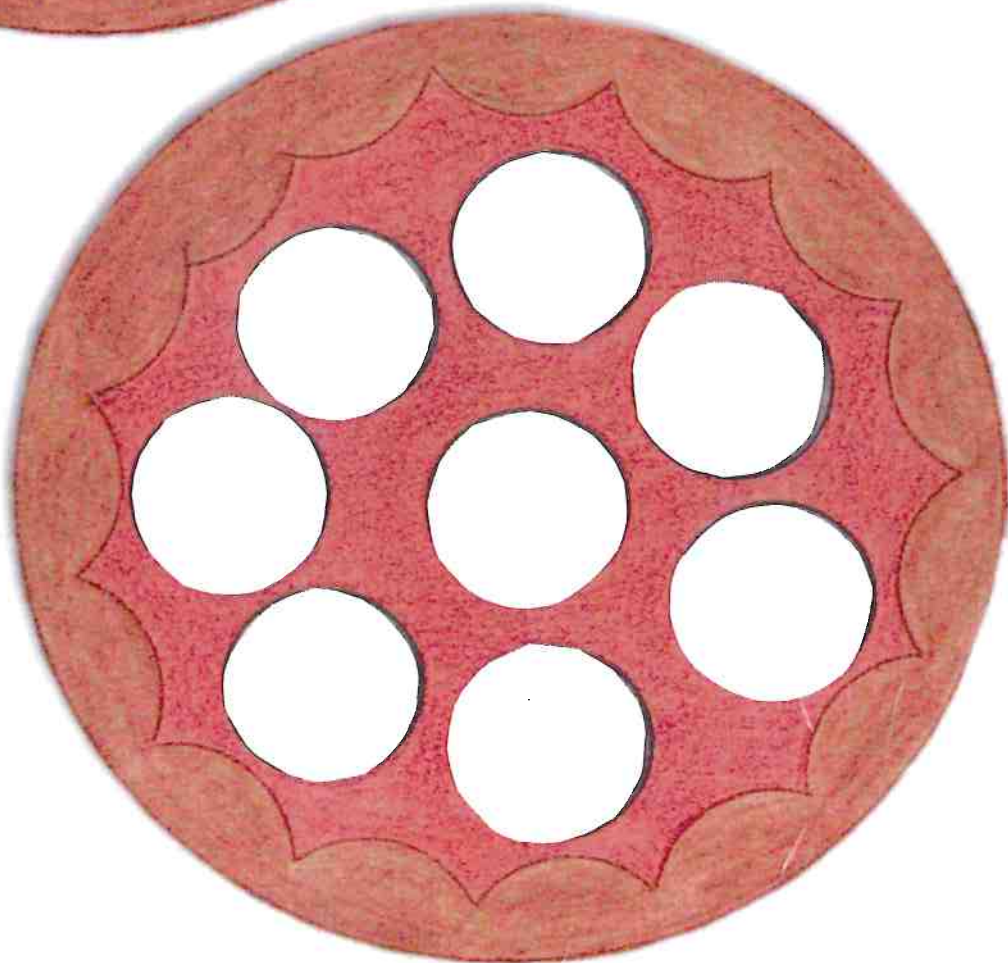
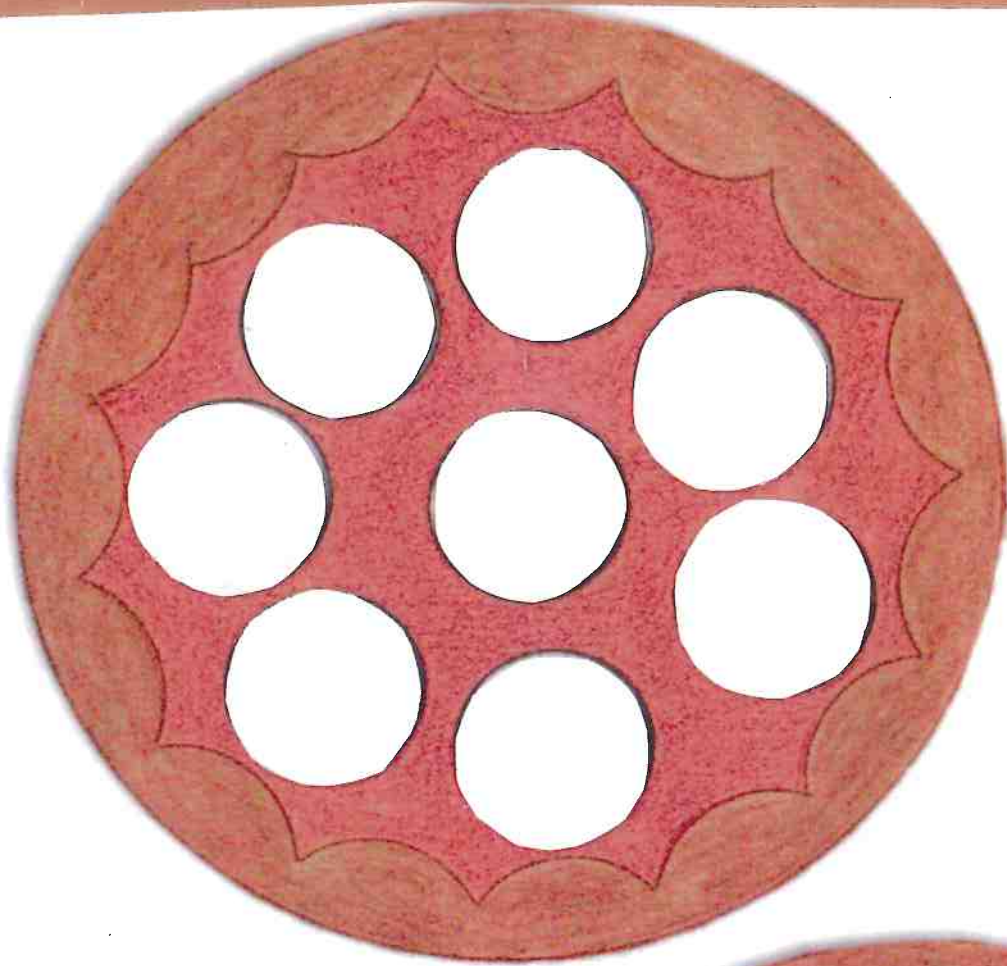
