

Statement of Guiding Principles for School-Community Relations

Policy No. 405.0

The Board of Education, School District No. 91 (Nechako Lakes), believes that the public education system must be open and accessible to all members of the community. This applies to the trustees who have been elected to represent their communities in meeting the educational needs of the community members as well as to all aspects of the system including the facilities, the programs and the operations of the district.

The Board recognizes that a regular and ongoing comprehensive communication program will enhance education opportunities for learners. Such communication needs to be two-way so the needs and interests of the community can be heard.

The Board further recognizes the special responsibility of communicating clearly and openly with parents of students in the district.
