Engaging the Workforce



- Educators at Mouse Mountain work together and collaborate in meaningful ways to support students.
 - Many teachers and CUPE members are involved in a Network of Inquiry and Indigenous Education inquiry project
 - All staff members have collaboration block to focus on learning new strategies that support learners, as well as evaluate the strategies they are currently using

- Mouse Mountain Elementary is focused on improving literacy and numeracy for all learners, as well as student well-being
 - All educators are inquiring into literacy best practice
 - Literacy and Numeracy District Support Teachers have been invited into collaboration blocks
