Our trustees have worked hard on this plan over the last year by reflecting on our current plan and working with stakeholder groups to articulate our priorities for the next five years.


Trustees are already being invited to speak about the plan and looking forward to connecting to schools, departments and community groups over the next two months to share their vision.

School Planning


