

# Poppin' Popcorn



## how to make:

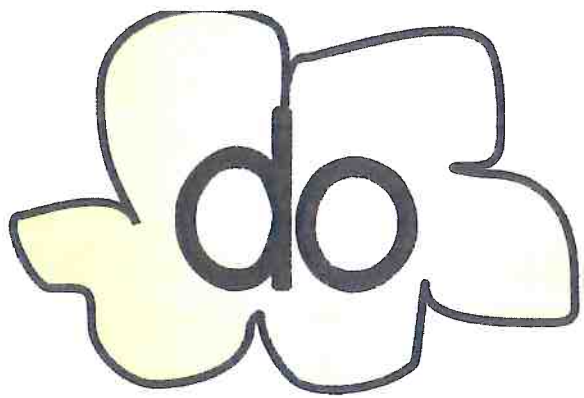
1. Print and laminate popcorn sight word pieces.
2. Place sight words and POP! pieces in an empty microwave popcorn box or purchase a plastic popcorn container. I found mine for \$1 in the dollar section at Target!

\*Teacher Tip: Have a popcorn party when students learn all of the sight words!

## how to play:

1. Without looking, the first player chooses a popcorn piece from the container.
2. The player reads the card. If he/she is correct, it is the next player's turn. If he/she is incorrect, other players help by reading the word. It is the next player's turn.

3. If a "POP!" piece is chosen, the player has to put all of his or her pieces back in the container. It is the next player's turn.
4. Keep playing until a given time is up. The player with the most pieces is the winner!
