GRASSY PLAINS UPDATE

Given our current information on the Southside fires, the School District will be delaying the start of the school year for Grassy Plains students until Monday, Sept. 17th. In the event that the current 'evacuation order' is lifted significantly prior to Sept. 17th we will adjust the start date accordingly. Should the 'Evacuation Order' remain in place beyond Sept. 17th, classes for Grassy students will begin in Burns Lake at a location to be announced.

If the alert is lifted between today and Sept. 4th, schools will run as normal as will our busses.

TRANSPORTATION UPDATE

We will be running our busses in **all** our communities, except as above. This includes routes that are currently in 'alert' zones. Our busses will not run in 'Evacuation Order' zones which currently only impact the Southside.
